

RESOLUTION NO. 2557

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING  
THOMPSON SPRINGS  
SPECIAL SERVICE FIRE DISTRICT**

**WHEREAS**, the Council of Grand County has heretofore determined that a Fire Service District is necessary in the Thompson Springs area to enhance and protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Grand County, and

**WHEREAS**, a hearing has been held, notices given and a determination made that protests have not been made by more than 50% of the qualified voters in the District or owners of more than 50% of taxable value of land in the District:

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the County Council of Grand County, Utah, as follows:

**Section 1.** The public economic welfare, convenience and necessity require the creation within Grand County, Utah of a Special Service District (the "District") pursuant to the provisions of the Utah Special Service District Act, Title 17A, Chapter 2, Sections 1301 et. seq.

**Section 2.** The boundaries of the District hereby established shall be as set forth in the Notice of Hearing in Section 7 hereof.

**Section 3.** The District is to be created for the purpose of providing fire suppression services.

**Section 4.** The District so created shall be known as "Thompson Springs Special Service Fire District.

**Section 5.** An Administrative Control Board consisting of three persons is hereby established pursuant to 17A-2-1326 Utah Code Annotated.

The following persons are appointed as initial members of the Board to serve terms of two (2) years or four (4) years as indicated:

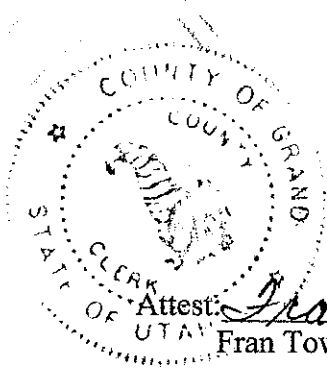
**Section 6.** The officers of Grand County, Utah, are hereby authorized and directed to take all action necessary or appropriate to effectuate the provisions of this resolution.

**Section 7.** If any one or more sections, sentences, clauses or parts of the resolution shall, for any reason, be questioned or held invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remaining provisions of this resolution, but shall be confined in its operation to the specific sections, sentences, clauses or parts of this resolution so held unconstitutional and invalid, and the inapplicability and invalidity of any section, sentence, clause or part of this resolution in any one or more instances shall not affect or prejudice in any way the applicability and validity of this resolution in any other instances.

**Section 8.** All Resolutions, by-laws and regulations of Grand County, Utah, in conflict with this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any resolution, by-law or regulation, or part thereof, heretofore repealed.

Beginning at the SW Corner Section 33, T 21 S, R 19 E, SLM, and proceeding thence East 1.5 miles to the South  $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner Section 34, T 21 S, R 19 E, SLM, thence Northeasterly approximately 3.6 miles to the SW Corner Section 29, T 21 S, R 20 E, SLM, thence East 3.5 miles to the South  $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner Section 26, T 21 S, R 20 E, SLM, thence North 1 mile to the North  $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner Section 26, T 21 S, R 20 E, SLM, thence Northwesterly approximately 1.8 miles to the NE Corner Section 21, T 21 S, R 20 E, SLM, thence West 2 miles to the NW Corner Section 20, T 21 S, R 20 E, SLM, thence Southwesterly approximately 5.2 miles to the West  $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner Section ~~26~~, T 21 S, R 19 E, SLM, thence South 1.5 miles to the point of beginning.
