TRUCKS AND COMMERCIAL VEHICLES

10.04.010 Prolonged idling of motor.

Prolonged idling of a motor in Grand County is prohibited. A person commits prolonged idling of a motor who, for a prolonged and unreasonable period of time, idles or permits the idling of the motor of any diesel-fuel-burning vehicle, or any other motor vehicle. For the purposes of this section, any period longer than fifteen (15) minutes is a prolonged and unreasonable period of time.

This section does not prohibit the idling of any motor for periods longer than fifteen (15) minutes if the idling occurs in a commercial truck stop, or in an area specifically designed as a truck stop by the sheriff's department. (Ord. 307 (part), 1999)

10.04.020 Jake brake use.

The use of engine retarders, or "jake brakes" or other similarly loud brakes within the following areas is prohibited within five miles of the Moab City incorporation limits. (Ord. 308 (part), 1999)

10.04.030 Prolonged parking in residential neighborhood.

Prolonged parking of a commercial vehicle with more than two axles on the public right-of-way in a residential neighborhood is prohibited. A person commits prolonged parking of a commercial vehicle with more than two axles who, for a prolonged and unreasonable period of time, parks such a vehicle on the public right-of-way in a residential neighborhood. For the purposes of this section, any period longer than fifteen (15) minutes is a prolonged and unreasonable period of time.

This section does not prohibit:

A. The parking of a commercial vehicle with more than two axles on the public right-of-way in a residential neighborhood for periods longer than fifteen (15) minutes if the parking occurs in a commercial truck stop, or in an area specifically designed as a truck stop by the sheriff's department; or

B. The parking of a delivery truck or moving van so long as they are in the process of loading or unloading. (Ord. 309 (part), 1999)

10.04.040 Violation--Penalty.

Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of this chapter or who shall fail to comply with any provision hereof within five miles of the corporate limits of the city of Moab shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be subject to a fine. Any person violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall be fined three hundred dollars (\$300.00) upon conviction, or imprisoned for a period of up to ninety (90) days, or both such fine and imprisonment. Each day any violation or noncompliance continues shall constitute a separate and distinct offense. (Ord. 309 (part), 1999; Ord. 308 (part), 1999; Ord. 307 (part), 1999)
