At the Grand County Council meetings/hearings any citizen, property owner, or public official may be heard on any agenda subject. The number of persons heard and the time allowed each may be limited at the sole discretion of the Chair. On matters set for public hearings there is a three-minute time limit per person to allow maximum public participation. All persons, upon being recognized by the Chair, shall advance to the podium, state their full name and address, whom they represent, and their subject matter. No person shall interrupt legislative proceedings.

The Grand County Council, Grand County's State Senator and two State Representatives invite Grand County registered voters who wish to be considered for serving on the five-member Appointment Council to submit a letter of interest. This new Appointment Council will select a seven-member Study Committee to study Grand County's Form of Government over the next year. Interested registered voters may not hold any public office or employment. Send letters of interest to council@grandcountyutah.net or Grand County Courthouse, Council's Office, 125 E Center St, Moab, UT 84532 **by 5PM on Wednesday, November 14, 2018**. All on-time letters of interest will be submitted to the Grand County Council who will make an appointment after 4PM on Tuesday, November 20, 2018 during an open, public meeting. Applicants who wish to address the County Council may do so during the meeting; applicants who cannot attend in person and wish to address the County Council may call in with 24 hours' advance notice to the Council's Office. Applicants are not required to attend or to call in to the meeting. All on-time letters of interest will also be submitted to Grand County's State Senator and the two state Representatives by email (via the Council's Office) on November 15, 2018, who, together, will select a second member to the five-member Appointment Council. The Appointment Council must convene between November 20 and November 30, 2018. The Appointment Council must appoint the seven-member Study Committee members within 30 days after the Appointment Council's first meeting.
