

# RECREATE RESPONSIBLY

**Grand County's world-class recreation economy welcomes a variety of recreational users seeking diverse experiences including mountain bikers, hikers, boaters, motorized Jeep/4x4 users, cyclists, climbers, motorcyclists, equestrians, hunters, bird watchers, and adventure athletes such as base-jumpers, slackliners, and skydivers.**

**In 2021, Grand County passed Title 11: Noise Pollution.**

In order to provide for and promote the health, safety, and peace of residents and visitors alike, and to preserve the quiet of the surrounding desert landscape, it is illegal to make or create excessive, unusual, or prolonged noise.

A violation of Title 11 is a Class B misdemeanor punishable by a maximum of up to six months in jail and a maximum fine of \$1000.00. Each day such a violation is committed or permitted to continue shall constitute a separate violation unless limited by Utah State Law.
